2009 "Take It Off The Streets" Autoslalom Series

The "Take it Off the Streets" Autoslalom Series is designed to cater to street driven Sport Compact Vehicles, however vehicles of all makes and models are welcome to participate. The series consists of five (5) events held at the Powerade Centre (Brampton). Events will run starting at the beginning of May until September. Three (3) events will be scored to determine class winners, which will provide two (2) "throw-away" events. In the final event, all series class winners will participate in a final shootout to determine the 2009 "Take it Off the Streets" Autoslalom Series "Top-Dawg". Class winners and the "Top-Dawg" will receive trophies to honour their accomplishments. All series registered participants are eligible for sponsor prizes*.

Series Classification:

Cars will be divided into 7 classes based off of the CASC-OR Autoslalom Provincial Series classification with certain classes and prep levels being grouped together:

MOD (Modified) – all MOD cars and purpose built race cars

SP (Street Prepared) – all SP classed cars

SS1 (Super Stock 1) – all ASS, BSS, and CSS cars

SS2 (Super Stock 2) – all DSS, ESS, and FSS cars

S1 (STOCK 1) – all AS, BS, and CS cars

S2 (STOCK 2) – all DS, ES, and GS cars

S3 (STOCK 3) – all FS and HS cars

All cars will be classified using the CASC-OR Provincial Classification guidelines. Once the car's Provincial class has been determined, it will then be grouped as above.

An exception will be made for our series regarding cars with a motor swap, due to the commonality and abundance of swaps available. Any car with a swap will be based one or more prep level(s) higher than the car's original motor prep level. Examples:

- If a car has a motor where the OEM engine mount locations are used, these cars will automatically go to SP. Example – An SS Honda Civic with a VTEC-B motor swap – goes to SP.
- If a car has a motor where the OEM mount locations are not used, these cars will automatically go to MOD. Example – An SS Honda Civic with a K-motor swap – goes to MOD.

The event officials reserve the right to class ANY car in ANY class if they believe that the car has been improperly classed or modifications were not disclosed.

Scoring:

A minimum of four (4) timed runs will be provided at each event. Only series registered participants will be eligible to receive points towards the championship; however all times will factor in when calculating points for series registered participants.

Finishing position will be determined by the fastest single lap time posted within each class. Fastest time will receive 100 points. All other competitors in the class will be scored based on their best time compared to the class winner's fastest time: class winner's fastest time/competitor's time X 100. Number will be rounded to three (3) decimal places.

Example:

Driver A best time – 45.000 seconds = 100.000 points (fastest time)

Driver B best time – 45.550 seconds = 98.793 points $((45.000/45.550)*100)$

Driver C best time – 47.250 seconds = 95.238 points $((45.000/47.250)*100)$

General Rules and Regulations

- All drivers must wear a Snell M00 or SA00 or newer helmet while on course. No DOT helmets allowed. A limited number of loaner helmets will be available. Participants are urged to provide their own. Also, only one loner helmet per car is allowed (ie. Driver and passenger cannot use two loner helmets).
- A maximum of one (1) passenger is allowed provided they have signed the waiver.
- All drivers must display their competition number and class in a contrasting colour, minimum 8" height, on both sides of the car. The upper portion of the front door is recommended however shoe polish on the rear quarter window is acceptable.
- Novice drivers (3 events or less) are required to display a visible triangle on the rear portion of their car (rear window or rear bumper). This triangle will easily identify novice drivers to the instructors. Novice drivers are encouraged to ask for ride alongs with instructors.
- All pylons knocked "down and/or out" on the course will be charged a two (2) second penalty per cone. All standing cones will be counted, however leaner cones will not.
- Off-courses will be charged a two hundred (200) second penalty.
- The decisions of the marshals and timing team are final. No protests will be accepted.
- A time sheet will be posted after each set heat of runs.
- Any practicing, tire warming, deliberate burnouts or excessive noise at any time will result in disqualification from the event. In addition, reckless or dangerous driving in the immediate area of the venue will result in the participant being disqualified and not permitted to return for the rest of the series. No refunds will be given. Local law enforcement authorities will be notified of the event details and have been urged to attend our events.
- All competitors MUST attend the driver's meeting prior to the start of each event.
- Competitors must prominently display series sponsor decals on both sides of the car.
- At any time, the Event and/or Series Organizers have the right to refuse entry or disqualify a competitor from competition for any reason whatsoever.
- This is a fun series therefore the organizers will not entertain complaints about the classifications system. Come on out and have a blast. Seat time is the key.

Event Costs

- \$30 per event including lunch (\$10 late fee after registration closes). Non-participants may purchase a lunch voucher at the beginning of the event for \$5.
- Series Registration: \$25 (Waived if all 5 events are paid up at the Open House ONLY). Series registration will be accepted up to the close of registration for Event 2.

Note: All registration fees are 100% non-refundable.

Benefits of Series Registration

- Eligible to score points toward the series championship
- Eligible to complete in the series Shoot-Out at the final event (series registered only)
- Eligible to win prizes* (prizes may be substituted for something of equal value.)
- Less paperwork at each event
